Food Security at Sabarimala to be given priority: Devaswom Board President

The foods and drinks sold to devotees in Sabarimala should be checked and the authorities have to ensure quality, said Devaswom Board President A Padmakumar. He also directed the Food Safety authorities to check the quality of drinking water distributed in the kiosks on an everyday basis.

President also said that the Sabarimala has become a place for certain mafia to exploit the devotees. This has to be strictly dealt with. Police should take action against such people. He also wanted the Forest officials to rehabilitate the wild pigs that posing threat to devotees. These pigs should be captured and properly rehabilitated. After the pilgrimage season, they should be freed, said the President. He also wanted the surveillance of the Excise and Fire Force to be strengthened at Sabarimala.
