Facility for preparing Irumudi at Pamba:

The Travancore Devaswom Board has set up a 24-hour facility for preparing Irumudi for pilgrims at Sabarimala. Pilgrims desirous of ascending the 18 holy steps should have Irumudi and on paying Rs.250, the Pamba Melsanthi would prepare the customary Irumudi for those reaching there. A special facility has been provided before the Pamba Ganapathy temple.

NSS free medical centre opened

Sabarimala Thanthri Kantararu Rajeevaru inaugurated the Mannam Memorial N.S.S. Free Medical Centre. Medical officers Dr.Jyothi Raj, Dr.Lalu Raj first attended to the patients who reached the centre. The medical centre has inpatient facility too. Police Special Officer Ramesh Kumar, NSS head office Superintendents Rajagopal,

P.B.Madhusudanan, staff member G.Anil Kumar and other officials attended the function.

3,000 pilgrims reach homoeo medical centre

Homoeo dispensaries that function round-the-clock have been set up at Sannidanam and Pamba. About 3,000 pilgrims sought assistance at the dispensaries so far. Treatment and medicines are being provided free of cost from the dispensaries. The service of two doctors led by the Pathanamthitta District Medical Officer are aware at the dispensaries. Two pharmacists, an attender and cleaner have been deployed at the dispensaries. The dispensary at Sannidanam is at the beginning of the Nadapanthal above the KSEB office. Contact Numbers. LPG cylinder godown inaugurated:

Travancore Devaswom Board member Ajay Tharayil inaugurated the LPG cylinder godown constructed by the board on Friday. The warehouse for storing 1,000 cylinders, was constructed on the board's land in a fortnight. This was aimed at avoiding commercial establishments storing large number of cylinders. Henceforth, hotels and other can secure cylinders from the warehouse. The procurement and distribution is being done by BPCL. Festival control officer Somasekharan Nair, Sabarimala executive officer T.V.Ravisankar, civil wing Assistant Engineer A.E.Basanth, and others also participated.

2547 pilgrims seek medical care:

As many as 2,547 pilgrims sought medical care at the hospitals and dispensaries in and around Pamba on Friday. With this, those availing of the facility since the season began rose to 23,279. In Pamba Government Dispensary 386 pilgrims, including 371 men, six women and nine kids turned up, of which 95 had heart-related ailments. At Neelimala dispensary, 58 men, 25 women and 18 children went for treatment. This included 31 heart patients too. At the Sannidhanam dispensary 1,016 pilgrims approached for treatment. This included 950 men, 19 women, 47 children and among them there were 204 heart patients too. At Apachimedu, there were 134 patients,

including 121 men, seven women and six children. 34 of them had heart-related ailments. There were 187 patients at Nilakkal, including 170 men, nine women and eight children. Five of them had heart-related diseases.
