BSNL launches seamless mobile facilities for 'Ayyappa devotees'

BSNL provides a seamless and powerful mobile service for devotees visiting Lord Ayyappa in Sabarimala. There are 13 towers at Sannidhanam. These will be served until after the Makara Vilakku. Sabarimala has provided with 3G services. Due to geographical features, there are only a few pockets where service is unavailable. That also being resolved as soon as the complaint is received. The BSNL team comprising 12 persons headed by Sub-Divisional Engineer Jayaraj OP is active. An online relationship has also been established between the Emergency Medical Center and the Emergency Operations Center. During the Makara Vilakku, the tower will be placed on the Pullmedu.

BSNL has made the free 3G SIM is available at BSNL Customer Care Center. Jyoti Nagar, Pandithalavam, and Pampa centers that devotees will get the free SIM. They have to bring their Aadhaar card to get the SIM for free. Free SIM has Voice calls and data service for five days free of charge. Customer Care Centers have also introduced a facility for billing and grievance redressal. High-speed broadband service is also provided to those in need.

BSNL has set up a free WiFi hotspot at Pandithavalam. Devotees can avail the service, BSNL said. The facility will have a 200-meter perimeter.

Homeopathy Treatment Center ready with all facilities

Pampa and Sannidhanam have a wide range of facilities for homeopathic treatment. Seven people are working in both centers. The team consists of two doctors, a pharmacist, an attendant, and a cleaning staff. Hundreds of people come in the two centers every day seeking Homeopathy treatment. Most people are treated with ailments like sore throat, sneezing, fever, colds, and cough. It also provides antibiotics for chickenpox and viral fever to the police on duty at Sabarimala. Medications for diseases, nebulization for rapid healing and vaporization using infrared light are available from the treatment center. Homeopathy Center is run by doctors Saji and Jyotish Kumar. The service is available 24 hours a day.
